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## Frequently Asked Questions

What are the names of the Mayor and Members of the City Council?

- Mayor Gloria Olmos, Mayor Pro Tem Angelica R. Garcia, Councilmember Richard Angel, Councilmember Hector Delgado, and Councilmember Joseph J. Gonzales.

When will the next city election be held and how long a term does each member serve?

- The next General Municipal Election will be held on November 7, 2017 for two Councilmember seats, each member serves a four-year term.
- A Special Municipal Election will be held on November 7, 2017 for an unexpired term ending November 2020.

Where can I register to vote?

- Voter registration cards are available in the City Clerk's Office, Post Office, Library and Los Angeles County Registrar Recorder/County Clerk's Office.

When and where are the City Council Meetings held?

- City Council meetings are held on the second and fourth Tuesday of each month at 6:30 p.m. in the City Hall, Council Chambers, located at 1415 N. Santa Anita Avenue, South El Monte.

When and where are the Successor Agency Meetings held?

- Successor Agency meetings are held on the fourth Tuesday of each month at 6:00 p.m. in the City Hall, Council Chambers, located at 1415 N. Santa Anita Avenue, South El Monte.

What city commissions are available that a resident serve on?

- There are three commissions that a resident can apply to serve on:  
Planning Commission – 5 members  
Community Services Commission – 9 members  
Patriotic Commission – 7 members

What qualifications are necessary to serve on one of the city commissions?

- In order to qualify for consideration you must be a resident of the City of South El Monte and complete a Commissioner's Office and Live Scan application. No city employee is eligible

Where and when can I apply to serve on a city commission?
