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## Frequently Asked Questions

What are the names of the Mayor and Members of the City Council?

- Mayor Gloria Olmos, Mayor Pro Tem Richard Angel, Councilmember Manuel Acosta, Councilmember Hector Delgado and Councilwoman Gracie Retamoza.

When will the next city election be held and how long a term does each member serve?

- The next General Municipal Election will be held in November 2020 and each member serves a four-year term.

Where can I register to vote?

- Voter registration cards are available in the City Clerk's Office, Post Office, Library and Los Angeles County Registrar Recorder/County Clerk's Office.

When and where are the City Council Meetings held?

- City Council meetings are held on the second and fourth Tuesday of each month at 6:00 p.m. in the City Hall, Council Chambers, located at 1415 N. Santa Anita Avenue, South El Monte.

When and where are the Successor Agency Meetings held?

- Successor Agency meetings are held on the fourth Tuesday of each month at 6:00 p.m. in the City Hall, Council Chambers, located at 1415 N. Santa Anita Avenue, South El Monte.

What city commissions are available that a resident serve on?

- There are three commissions that a resident can apply to serve on:  
Planning Commission – 5 members  
Community Services Commission – 7 members  
Patriotic Commission – 5 members

What qualifications are necessary to serve on one of the city commissions?

- In order to qualify for consideration you must be a resident of the City of South El Monte and complete a Commissioner's Office and Live Scan application. No city employee is eligible.

Where and when can I apply to serve on a city commission?
