

ORDINANCE NO. 1226

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SOUTH EL MONTE  
DECREASING THE NUMBER OF COMMUNITY SERVICES  
COMMISSIONERS FROM NINE TO SEVEN MEMBERS AND  
DECREASING THE NUMBER OF PATRIOTIC COMMISSIONERS  
FROM SEVEN TO FIVE MEMBERS

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOUTH EL MONTE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1: The City Council hereby directs the City Clerk to revise Municipal Code Section 2.48.020 of Title 2 (Administration & Personnel) to reduce the membership of the Community Services Commission from nine members to seven members.

Section 2: The City Council hereby directs the City Clerk to revise Municipal Code Section 2.58.020 of Title 2 (Administration & Personnel) to reduce the membership of the Patriotic Commission from seven members to five members.

Section 3: The City Council hereby amends Section 2.58.030 (Compensation of members) to read as follows:

“Section 2.58.030 Compensation of members.

Each member of the patriotic commission shall be compensated at such rate as the city council may from time to time fix by resolution.”

Section 4: The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this ordinance.
